#### ***Client Rights and Important Information:***

- You are entitled to receive information from me about my methods of therapy, the techniques I use, the duration of your therapy (if I can determine it), and my fee structure. Please ask if you would like to receive this information.
- You can seek a second opinion from another therapist or terminate therapy at any time.
- In a professional relationship (such as ours), sexual intimacy between a therapist and a client is never appropriate. If sexual intimacy occurs, it should be reported to the State Grievance Board.

Generally speaking, the information provided by and to a client during therapy sessions is legally confidential. When information is legally confidential, the therapist cannot be forced to disclose the information without the client's consent. Exceptions to the general rule of confidentiality are listed in the Colorado statutes (see section 12-43-218, C.R.S. (July 1998) in particular.

Payment of fee is due at time of therapy. In order to allow me to schedule clients, 24 hours advance notice of cancellation will be required or payment for the session will be expected. There is no charge for brief phone calls. Calls lasting longer than 10 minutes will generally be charged to the client on a pro-rated basis. Reports requested by insurance companies, etc. will not be released without your permission. Charges for reports will be pro-rated based on \$150 per hour.
